

Matthias Brenzinger

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Dr. Brenzinger is senior lecturer at the University of Cape Town, South Africa. He organized several international conferences focusing on endangered languages (since 1990) and edited several volumes on that topic. He conducted extensive fieldwork and published various languages, such as Yaaku in Kenya, Ma'a in Tanzania, Bayso in Ethiopia, Khwe in Namibia, Botswana, Angola and Zambia. He supported communities' language maintenance activities, such as the development of practical orthographies for Khwe and Ts'ixa, and assisted as a consultant in the implementation of mother tongue education in Ethiopia. Since the mid-1990s he is involved in UNESCO activities and projects related to endangered language issues, such as chairperson of the *UNESCO Ad-hoc Expert Group on Endangered Language* and regional director for Africa in the *UNESCO atlas of the world's languages in danger*. He is Secretary General of *WOCAL (World Congress of African Linguistics)*.

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
