Wim van Zanten taught at the Department of Cultural Anthropology and Development Sociology, Leiden University, from 1971-2007. Most of his publications are based on his fieldwork on music in Malawi (1969-1971, 2008) and Indonesia (1976-present) and some are about methodological issues in anthropology and ethnomusicology, including statistics for the social sciences. He has been involved in shaping the 2003 UNESCO *Convention for the safeguarding of the intangible cultural heritage* since 2002 and published a few articles about this. He was member of the Executive Board (1996-2004, 2009-2011) and one of the Vice Presidents (2005-2009) of the International Council for Traditional Music (ICTM).
